This website uses cookies. Some cookies are strictly necessary to make the website work; others are optional and help us understand how the website is used or improve its functionality. This Cookie Policy explains what cookies are, which ones we use, and how you can control them.

This policy should be read together with our Privacy Policy, which explains more generally how we handle personal data.

1. WHAT ARE COOKIES?

Cookies are small text files that are placed on your device when you visit a website. They are widely used to make websites work, or work more efficiently, as well as to provide reporting information to the website owner.

Cookies set by us are called “first-party cookies.” Cookies set by parties other than us are called “third-party cookies.” Third-party cookies enable third-party features or functionality to be provided on or through our website (for example, payment processing or analytics). We may also use similar technologies, such as local storage and web beacons, which work in a similar way to cookies.

2. WHAT COOKIES DO WE USE, AND WHY?

The law allows us to store cookies on your device where they are strictly necessary for the operation of this site. For all other types of cookies, we need your permission, which you can give or withdraw at any time using our cookie consent banner.

We currently use (or intend to use) cookies from the following categories. The specific cookies listed below are illustrative placeholders based on the tools discussed for likelyeducation.com — see the drafting notes at the end of this document for how to replace them with an accurate list.

2.1 Strictly necessary cookies

These cookies are essential for the website and platform to work — for example, keeping you logged in, remembering your Class and Task progress mid-session, and protecting against cross-site request forgery. You cannot opt out of these cookies, as the Services cannot function without them.

2.3 Analytics / statistics cookies

At this stage, LIKELY does not use any analytics cookies or tools. If we add an analytics tool in the future (for example, to understand which pages are visited or how long Tasks take to complete), this section will be updated to list the relevant cookies, and consent will be requested via the cookie banner first if the tool we choose isn't cookie-free.

2.4 Marketing cookies

At this stage, LIKELY does not plan to use third-party advertising or marketing cookies (for example, to serve targeted adverts or share data with ad networks such as Meta or Google Ads). If this changes in the future, this section will be updated to list the relevant cookies, and consent will be requested via the cookie banner before any such cookies are set.

3. HOW CAN I CONTROL COOKIES?

You can accept or reject non-essential cookies at any time using the cookie consent banner shown when you first visit the Website, or via the cookie settings link in the website footer. Strictly necessary cookies cannot be rejected, as the Services cannot function without them.

You can also set or amend your web browser controls to accept or refuse cookies, or to alert you when a cookie is being set. As the method for doing this varies by browser, please check your browser's help menu for instructions. If you choose to reject cookies through your browser, you may still be able to use the Website, though some functionality may not work as intended.

4. COOKIES AND CHILDREN

Many Students who use the Services are under 18. We aim to keep our use of cookies as minimal and privacy-protective as possible in light of this — in particular by avoiding marketing/advertising cookies altogether (Clause 2.4) and favouring analytics tools that minimise or avoid the use of persistent identifying cookies (Clause 2.3).

5. OTHER TRACKING TECHNOLOGIES

In addition to cookies, we may use similar technologies such as local storage (to store information directly in your browser) and, occasionally, web beacons or tracking pixels (small graphic files that let us know a page has been viewed, for example in a support or account-related email). These are used only for the purposes described in this policy.

6. CHANGES TO THIS COOKIE POLICY

We may update this Cookie Policy from time to time to reflect changes to the cookies we use, or for other operational, legal, or regulatory reasons. The “Last updated” date at the top of this page shows when it was last revised. Please revisit this page occasionally to stay informed.
